

**MOHAWK LIFTS DOES NOT HAVE AN INDIANA CONTRACT FOR VEHICLE LIFTS AND GARAGE EQUIPMENT.**

**HOWEVER; BELOW IS INDIANA'S STATE STATUTE WHICH ALLOWS THE USE OF ANOTHER STATES CONTRACT (or FEDERAL GSA, or HGAC, or MARC) AS CONTRACTING VEHICLES TO PROCURE LIFTS AND GARAGE EQUIPMENT.**

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Title 36 Local Government Article 1 General Provisions Chapter 7 Interlocal Cooperation</b></p>
<p><b>IC 36-1-7-1</b> Sec. 1. This chapter applies to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(1) The state.</li><li>(2) All political subdivisions.</li><li>(3) All state agencies.</li><li>(4) Another state to the extent authorized by the law of that state.</li><li>(5) Political subdivisions of states other than Indiana, to the extent authorized by laws of the other states.</li><li>(6) Agencies of the federal government, to the extent authorized by federal laws.</li></ul>
<p><b>IC 36-1-7-2</b> Sec. 2. (a) A power that may be exercised by an Indiana political subdivision and by one (1) or more other governmental entities may be exercised:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(1) by one (1) or more entities on behalf of others; or</li><li>(2) jointly by the entities.</li></ul> <p>Entities that want to do this must, by ordinance or resolution, enter into a written agreement under section 3 or 9 of this chapter.</p>
